Man Up Lacrosse LLC is focused on having athletes develop their game year round to compete at the highest level possible. We believe that dedicated and relentless hard work will not only increase player fundamentals and athletic ability, but will also help these athletes grow as men and learn the true meaning of leadership. We will take this additional time over the summer months to work to make each player better than they were when they arrived. We are committed at Man Up Lacrosse LLC to do whatever it takes to not only grow the game of lacrosse in northeast Ohio, but to honor it as well.

Travel teams serve two main purposes. The primary reason is keep a stick in your sons' hand year round giving him an additional opportunity to get additional touches in gameplay situations and in turn, become a better all around player. The second is to get additional coaching from a different lens and this, paired with additional gameplay, can showcase each player's talent to college coaches in hopes to achieve a spot on a college roster or to earn an athletic scholarship. All attended tournaments will have numerous collegiate coaches on hand scouting for the upcoming years.

Each team will be comprised of no more than 25 players and a minimum of two qualified coaches. Each team will have a minimum of 10 practices and will play a minimum of 12 games spread over three tournament events.

Three tournaments will be chosen for the 2026 Summer season.

Tournament 1 – June (mid to late)

Tournament 2 – Mid June – Early July

Tournament 3 – July (mid)

Expected Travel Teams for Summer 2026

"Varsity" Select Team: High School graduation years of 2027/2028

"Junior Varsity" Select Team: High School graduation years between 2028 – 2030

If enough players are interested, we will create a third team which will alter the aforementioned groups.

Team Try Outs: The indoor leagues are used as our tryout period. If a player is interested in playing on the Summer teams, please notify any of the staff and we will evaluate your game and discuss opportunities.

Cost to Participate: \$900 per player. This fee covers the costs of tournament registration, insurance fees, uniform depreciation fees, field rental for practices, equipment overhead, coaches travel fees, and coaching staff stipends. This fee does not cover, nor is Man Up Lacrosse responsible for, travel expenses of families or players. Fee can be paid all at once or in two installments due April 15, 2026 and June 15, 2026.
